

CHURCH OF SAINT FRANCIS OF ASSISI ALSO CALLED CHURCH “DEL CARMINE”

The village “Campo” and the church “del Carmine”



This church dates back to the fourteenth century. It was built outside the boundary city walls and in front of the castle. Its portal is in gothic style. The interior of the church has only one nave with chapels to the left side and keeps the original architecture, which was several times restored. Next to the entrance, there is a chapel consecrated to St. Anthony, covered with a small dome in the shape of a trullo. The original plant belonged to the ancient monastery of the Franciscan friars (the Observants). Restoration work on the church (on the inside and on the outside) has started several months ago and it is still going on (2009) by fits and starts. So far only the roof of the church has been restored.
